## **Call to Worship:**

#### **Confession of Sin:**

#### **Assurance of Pardon:**

All: Grace upon grace, Jesus relentlessly pursued an undeserving people. A crown of thorns, mocked and scorned, Jesus took our place. See the cross of Christ and behold the sacrifice of our Savior. Behold the resurrected King and be transformed by the glory of our God. We lift up our eyes and see Jesus there.
