Call to Worship:

Leader: Thus says the LORD: “If you return, I will restore you, and you shall stand before me. For I am with you to save you and deliver you,” declares the LORD.

All:

Confession of Sin:

Assurance of Pardon:

All: “It is finished,” was our Savior’s cry from the cross. Our debt has been paid in full. We are no longer slaves to sin; our guilt has been erased. Instead of shame, we receive God’s love and favor, because Jesus died and rose again. Praise the LORD, O my soul, for He has set you free! <Based on John 19:30; Psalm 103:2>

Leader: My beloved brothers and sisters, let us rejoice in the fact that Christ has been raised from the dead. Let us give thanks to God, who gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ.
