Call to Worship:

Confession of Sin:

While at times I acknowledge with my lips that differing viewpoints and a diverse pool of perspectives can be rewarding, in practice I am partial to stick with those who share my ideology and views on public policy. I am reluctant to take a posture of listening. I am quick to weaponize my opinions. Forgive me, God, for I am a catalyst for division.

Assurance of Pardon:

Leader: Remember, people of God, you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, living in the passions of your flesh and carrying out the desires of the body and the mind like the rest of mankind. But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, made us alive together with Christ.

All: By grace we have been saved! By Jesus' great sacrifice on the cross and great victory over the grave, we who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. He himself is our peace. He has made us one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility.
